**SB 1134** – By Jolley et. al. of the Senate and Duncan et. al. of the House..  
Jurors; adding exemptions. Effective date.

**CS for SB 1146** – By Jolley of the Senate and Jackson of the House..  
Intoxicating liquors; relating to low-point beer; modifying procedures for  
manufacturers and wholesalers; prohibiting low-point beer consumption at residence;  
providing penalties. Emergency.

**SB 1178** – By Nichols of the Senate and Terrill of the House..  
Professions and occupations; modifying duty of secretary of the State Board of  
Medical Licensure and Supervision; modifying date of transmittal. Effective date.
