Workers' compensation; modifying eligibility for extension of benefits. Effective date.

HB 1601 – By Sullivan et. al. of the House and Coffee et. al. of the Senate..

Attorneys; prohibiting attorney and employer from deducting certain monies for purpose of contributing to political funds. Effective date.

HB 1975 – By Moore et. al. of the House and Brown et. al. of the Senate..

Health care coverage legislation; specifying time period for introduction of bills mandating certain health coverage; exception to time period for introduction; requiring report assessing impacts of certain health coverage. Effective date.

HB 2161 – By Kern et. al. of the House and Stanislawski et. al. of the Senate..
Schools; prohibiting political speakers from speaking or distribution of political material at certain teacher meetings for political purposes, with exception. Effective date.

HB 2167 – By McCullough et. al. of the House and Sykes et. al. of the Senate..
State government; creating the Private Attorney Retention Sunshine Act. Effective date.

HB 2176 – By Nelson et. al. of the House and Aldridge et. al. of the Senate..
State officials; relating to crimes against state property and revenue; prohibiting certain person from soliciting licensees regarding legislation; providing exemption; relating to the Oklahoma Program Performance Budgeting and Accountability Act; providing penalty for certain agencies. Effective date. Emergency.

HB 2246 – By Terrill et. al. of the House and Brogdon et. al. of the Senate..
Initiative and referendum; modifying various provisions of initiative and referendum process; creating the Initiative and Referendum Task Force. Effective date. Emergency

HJR 1003 – By Key et. al. of the House and Brogdon et. al. of the Senate..
Sovereignty; claiming sovereignty under the Tenth Amendment to the United States Constitution.
