Information

The map on the reverse side of this sheet indicates various parking lots. Buses, cars, or vans may unload at the main entrance to the Capitol on the south side. Any cars or vans may then be parked in any space in the parking lot south of the Capitol that does not have a specific number marked or listed as reserved.

Buses will need to unload and then travel east to the parking lot directly adjacent to the Governor’s mansion. When leaving the Capitol go east on 21st street and then north on Phillips. The entrance to that parking lot is off of Phillips.

If you are walking from the parking lot adjacent to the Governor’s Mansion, you will find a tunnel entrance on the northeast corner of the parking lot that will take you to the basement of the Capitol. Stairways or elevators can take you to the 1st floor.

Upon leaving, the buses can again pick up on the south side of the Capitol. There will be Sergeant at Arms marked autos in the parking lots if you need assistance.
