**First Regular Session of the Fifty-first Legislature
of the State of Oklahoma
Sixtieth Legislative Day, Wednesday, May 16, 2007**

The House was called to order by Speaker Pro Tempore Blackwell.

The roll was called with 100 Members present.

The following Member was excused: Gilbert.—1.

The Speaker Pro Tempore declared a quorum present.

Prayer was offered by Pastor Norman Dake, Ascension Lutheran Church, Tulsa. Pastor Dake was sponsored this legislative day by Representative Peters.
