

# HOUSE JOURNAL

## Second Regular Session of the Fifty-first Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

### Thirty-second Legislative Day, Monday, March 31, 2008

The House was called to order by Speaker Pro Tempore Blackwell.

The roll was called with 101 Members present.

The Speaker Pro Tempore declared a quorum present.

Prayer was offered by Bishop Tony Miller, Senior Pastor, Cathedral of Praise, Oklahoma City. Bishop Miller was sponsored by Representative Thompson.

Upon motion of Representative Thompson, Bishop Miller was confirmed as House Chaplain for this legislative day.

Upon motion of Representative Thompson, Bishop Miller's prayer was ordered printed in full as follows:

“Father God, we come to you, the Creator of heaven and earth, the Holy One who revealed yourself to mankind as the eternal ‘I AM’ – the covenant-keeping God. We acknowledge today that You are the only true God, King of Kings and Lord of Lords. We are aware that our ability to serve the people of this great state has been given to us by Your sovereign will and divine appointment.

Today, as we seek first your Kingdom, your Word instructs us to pray for all those who are in authority so that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life, so now I lift my voice to you, asking that you will bless those who have been entrusted with the stewardship of leading our state. I ask that you would grant to each man and woman that is present here the strength to lead and the wisdom and discernment to make decisions. We ask for the integrity and strength of character, so that their decisions will be without prejudice or partiality. Give them the desire and the fortitude to serve all the people, regardless of race or creed.

Father, today we humble ourselves before you. We ask you to forgive our sins and heal our land. Where we have failed to love, may we practice forgiveness and restoration. May we truly be one nation, under God. Where we have failed to honor, would you remind us of our need to honor.

We pray for all that are serving our nation today in war. We ask for your protection and grace to be upon their lives. As they protect and defend our freedoms, give them strength and courage, in the face of great danger. Bless their families as they experience the stress of separation.

Thank you for supplying all of our needs, our daily bread. We are truly a blessed people. Continue to bring increase and expansion to our cities and counties.

Now unto Him that is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, beyond all we could ever ask or think, be all Glory and Honor, power and dominion, both now and forevermore. Amen.”
