“SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Article XXX to read as follows:

**ARTICLE XXX**

Section 1. A. The English language is the official language of the State of Oklahoma.

B. The State of Oklahoma and any political subdivision, institution, instrumentality or agency thereof shall not be required to print materials in any language other than English, except to the extent required by state or federal regulations or law.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

Legislative Referendum No. \_\_\_\_\_

State Question No. \_\_\_\_\_

**THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:**

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It would add a new Article 30.

It would make English the official language of the state. It would not require the state or state agencies to print materials in any language other than English.

**SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?**

**FOR THE PROPOSAL — YES** \_\_\_\_\_

**AGAINST THE PROPOSAL — NO** \_\_\_\_\_

SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall, immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.

SECTION 4.
