MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE

Announcing the passage of **SBs 254, 481, 822, 902, 1138, 1141 and 1175**. The measures were introduced and read for the first time.

SB 254 – By Corn, Garrison, Eason McIntyre, Ballenger, Paddack, Easley, Burrage and Johnson (Constance) of the Senate and Terrill of the House.

[children - grandparents - adoption - home studies - codification - effective date]

SB 481 – By Lamb, Rice, Johnson (Constance), Marlatt and Crutchfield of the Senate and Nelson and Sullivan of the House.

[revenue and taxation - modifying tax credit - effective date - emergency]

SB 822 – By Branan of the Senate and Hickman of the House.

An Act relating to state government; creating the Task Force on the Review of Health Insurance Mandates; providing for membership; requiring initial meeting to be called by certain date; providing for election of chair and vice-chair; specifying quorum requirements; providing for staffing; providing for travel reimbursement; stating duties of the task force; requiring certain report; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

SB 902 – By Brown of the Senate and Ritze of the House.

[boating safety - vessel operation - limiting liability - codification - effective date - emergency]

SB 1138 – By Easley of the Senate and McDaniel (Jeannie) of the House.

[crimes and punishments - child endangerment - DUI - effective date - emergency]

SB 1141 – By Johnson (Constance) of the Senate and Peterson of the House.

[domestic abuse - Domestic Violence Registration Act - requiring registration - Department of Corrections to develop registry - criminalizing certain acts - penalty - codification - effective date]

SB 1175 – By Stanislawski and Mazzei of the Senate and Watson of the House.

[labor - Oklahoma Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund Security Act of 2009 - codification - noncodification - effective date]
