While HB 1600 was presumably designed to provide clarification of workers' compensation cases involving surgery, it is bad policy and would result in unintended consequences that would increase costs to businesses by forcing injured workers to undergo invasive surgeries and denying them the option of pursuing a less costly and more conservative treatment course prior to surgery.
