FIRST READING

The following was introduced and read for the first time:

HB 2271 – By Dank.

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Sections 1221, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 485, O.S.L. 2002 and 1222 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 1221), which relate to state and tribal relations; modifying the approval requirements for cooperative agreements with federally recognized tribal governments; deleting approval requirements for certain cooperative agreements; modifying responsibilities of the Joint Committee on State-Tribal Relations; deleting quorum requirements; amending Section 10, Chapter 58, O.S.L. 2003 (3A O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 709), which relates to the powers of the Oklahoma Lottery Commission; modifying approval requirements for cooperative agreements with federally recognized tribal governments; and providing an effective date.
