ENGROSSED AND ENROLLED MEASURES

HBs 1479, 1574, 1903, 2310, 2324, 2647, 2686, 2695, 2703, 2753, 2800, 2814, 2815, 2852, 2888, 2932, 3123, 3127, 3190, 3287, 3311, 3344, 3354, 3385, 3397 and HJRs 1018, 1054, 1058 and 1070 were reported correctly engrossed, properly signed, in open session, and ordered transmitted to the Honorable Senate.

MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE

Announcing the passage of the following engrossed measures: **SBs 1328, 1340, 1389, 1650, 1796, 1936, 1996, 2099, 2148** and **SJR 61** and **66**.

The measures were introduced and read for the first time.

SB 1328 – By Gumm of the Senate and Terrill of the House.

[revenue and taxation - sales tax - codification - effective date]

SB 1340 – By Ellis of the Senate and Pruett of the House.

[agriculture - creating the “Kennel Definitions Act” - codification - effective date]

SB 1389 – By Jolley of the Senate and Cox of the House.

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 18c, as last amended by Section 8, Chapter 405, O.S.L. 2005 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 18c), which relates to the employment of attorneys; permitting the State Board of Pharmacy to appoint attorneys; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

SB 1650 – By Brogdon and Branan of the Senate and Watson of the House.

[revenue and taxation - gross production tax - effective date - emergency]

SB 1796 – By Lerblance and Johnson (Constance) of the Senate and Renegar of the House.

[drug court programs - driving privileges - effective date]

SB 1936 – By Corn of the Senate and Pruett and Peters of the House.

[children - permitting Office of Juvenile Affairs to sell real estate - directing deposit - utilization of monies - codification - effective date - emergency]

SB 1996 – By Coffee of the Senate and Benge of the House.

[workers’ compensation - requiring certain partnership - noncodification - effective date]

SB 2099 – By Brogdon of the Senate and Jordan of the House.

[professions and occupations - permits and fees - Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission - emergency]

SB 2148 – By Wilson of the Senate and Brown of the House.

An Act relating to the Governmental Tort Claims Act; amending 51 O.S. 2001, Section 152, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 315, O.S.L. 2009 (51 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 152), which relates to definitions; modifying definition; and providing an effective date.

SJR 61 – By Coffee of the Senate and Benge of the House.

[Joint Resolution - Task Force on Taxation of Intangible Ad Valorem Property - directing filing]

SJR 66 – By Coffee of the Senate and Sullivan of the House.

[workers’ compensation - claims for services - providing ballot title - directing filing]
