Second Regular Session of the Fifty-second Legislature

of the State of Oklahoma

Sixth Legislative Day, Tuesday, February 9, 2010

The House was called to order by Speaker Pro Tempore Steele.

The roll was called with 100 Members present.

The following Member was excused: Osborn.—1.

The Speaker Pro Tempore declared a quorum present.

Prayer was offered by Pastor Cody Deevers, Velma Baptist Church, Velma. Pastor Deevers was sponsored by Representative Holland.

Upon motion of Representative Faught, Pastor Deevers was confirmed as House Chaplain for this legislative day.

The Journal for the last legislative day was approved.

HBs 2284, 2286, 2299, 2371, 2372 and 2571 were reported correctly engrossed, properly signed, in open session, and ordered transmitted to the Honorable Senate.

GENERAL ORDER

HB 2750 by Denney et al of the House and Justice of the Senate was read and considered.

Representative Nelson moved to amend **HB 2750**, Page 2, Section 1, Line 1 by deleting the words “effect government change” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “change their government”, which amendment was declared adopted.

Representative Denney moved that **HB 2750** be advanced from General Order, which motion was declared adopted.
