First Regular Session of the Fifty-third Legislature

of the State of Oklahoma

Twenty-seventh Legislative Day, Thursday, March 24, 2011

The House was called to order by Speaker Steele.

The roll was called with 98 Members present.

The following Members were excused: Enns, Richardson, Ritze.--3

The Speaker declared a quorum present.

Prayer was offered by Pastor David McAllister, Unity Missionary Baptist Church, Duncan.

The Journal for the last legislative day was approved.

ENGROSSED AND ENROLLED MEASURES

HCRs 1007 and **1009** were reported correctly engrossed, properly signed, in open session, and ordered transmitted to the Honorable Senate.

MEASURES REASSIGNED

The following measures were reassigned:

SB 325 – Withdrawn from Appropriations and Budget and referred to Public Safety.

SB 637 – Withdrawn from Agriculture, Wildlife and Environment and referred to Administrative Rules and Government Oversight.

SB 708 – Withdrawn from Judiciary and referred to Economic Development, Tourism and Financial Services.

MOTION

Representative Sullivan moved that the Honorable Senate be notified by message that the House of Representatives is organized and ready to convene in Joint Session, which was the order.

MOTION

Representative Sullivan moved that the House stand in recess awaiting the arrival of the Honorable Senate, which was the order.

JOINT SESSION

The Third Joint Session of the First Regular Session of the Fifty-third Legislature assembled in the House Chamber on Thursday, March 24, 2011, and was called to order by Speaker Steele.

Senator Schulz moved that the attendance roll call of the Senate be considered the roll call of the Senate in Joint Session, which was the order.

Representative Sullivan moved that the attendance roll call of the House be considered the roll call of the House in Joint Session, which was the order.

Speaker Steele declared quorums of the Senate and House present and the Joint Session duly assembled.

Speaker Steele recognized Jerry Riley, Oklahoma Veterans Council Chaplain, who offered the invocation.

Chaplain Riley led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Speaker Steele addressed the Joint Session.

Speaker Steele recognized President Pro Tempore Bingman who addressed the Joint Session.

Speaker Steele recognized Oklahoma Veterans Council Chairman Pete Peterson who conducted the Veterans Awareness Day Ceremony.

Chairman Peterson addressed the Joint Session.

Chairman Peterson recognized Representative Wesselhoft, Chair of the House Veterans and Military Affairs Committee who introduced the House Veterans committee members.

Chairman Peterson recognized Senator Russell, Co-Chair of the Senate Veterans and Military Affairs Committee who introduced the Senate Veterans committee members.

Chairman Peterson recognized Chaplain Jerry Riley, Oklahoma Veterans Council, who offered the closing benediction.

Upon motion of Representative Sullivan, the Joint Session was ordered dissolved at 10:20 a.m.
