First Regular Session of the Fifty-third Legislature

Fourth Legislative Day, Monday, February 14, 2011

The House was called to order by Speaker Pro Tempore Hickman.

The roll was called with 100 Members present.

The following Member was excused: Jackson.—1.

The Speaker Pro Tempore declared a quorum present.
