SB 1971 by Jolley et al of the Senate and Sears et al of the House as considered and laid over on Page 1271 was called up for further consideration.

During Representative Sears' previous debate on the motion to adopt the Joint Committee Report on **SB 1971**, Representative Sears requested that **SB 1971** be laid over.

Upon being recognized by the Presiding Officer for further consideration of the Joint Committee Report on **SB 1971**, Representative Sears pressed his motion to adopt the Joint Committee Report and requested permission to yield to Representative Cox for continued presentation of the Joint Committee Report, to which no objection was heard. Representative Cox explained the Joint Committee Report, including an explanation of his

previous misunderstandings of the Joint Committee Report, and concluded with a request of the House to adopt the Joint Committee Report.

Upon inquiry by the Presiding Officer, Representatives Sears waived the remainder of his debate time and the Presiding Officer put the question of adoption of the Joint Committee Report to the House.

Representative Reynolds raised a point of order as to whether additional time for debate on the Joint Committee Report should be permitted and whether the author of a bill may properly withdraw his or her measure from further consideration in the course of their own debate or during the debate of other members.

The Presiding Officer ruled that the author of a bill may choose to withdraw his or her bill from further consideration during their own debate or between the conclusion and beginning of debate of other members, but that the Presiding Officer would not recognize such a request made by the author during the debate of another member.

On the question of whether debate should be allowed again on the motion to adopt the Joint Committee Report on **SB 1971**, the Presiding Officer did not rule on the question but relied upon Section 245 of *Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure*, putting the question directly to the House, which question was answered in the negative by the House upon a division of the question.

Representative Sears was recognized to continue his debate with the same amount of remaining time as was available when the measure had been previously withdrawn by Representative Sears.

Representative Reynolds raised a point of order as to whether it was in order to recognize Representative Sears to continue his debate, which the Presiding Officer ruled the point not well taken.

REMARKS

Upon unanimous consent request of Representative Thomsen, the remarks made by Associate Pastor Douglas Matlock on Friday, May 25, 2012, were ordered printed in full as follows:

“Acts 12:20-23, Romans 13:1, Matthew 23:11-12, Psalms 76:12

There are many similarities between Representatives and Ministers, which may strike some as funny. Both are selected by people to serve, both put in so many more hours than everyone knows or thinks, both receive compliments but probably more complaints, and most importantly both serve people. The Bible tells a story of a leader who made a critical mistake. Acts chapter 12 tells the story of King Herod.

20 Now Herod was angry with the people of Tyre and Sidon, and they came to him with one accord, and having persuaded Blastus, the king's chamberlain, they asked for peace, because their country depended on the king's country for food. **21** On an appointed day Herod put on his royal robes, took his seat upon the throne, and delivered a speech to them. **22** And the people were shouting, ‘The voice of a god, and not of a man!’

23 Immediately an angel of the Lord struck him down, because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and breathed his last.

Many of us will recognize the name Herod from the Christmas stories of Jesus, but this is actually one of Herod’s grandsons. He actually does some great things for the people in a time of need, but he makes a grave error: he forgot that power comes from the Lord and from the people.

The Apostle Paul wrote in Romans **13:1, 1** ‘Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.’ And Jesus said in **Matthew 23:11-12, 11** ‘The greatest among you shall be your servant. **12** Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.’

Now, we may not die from worms like Herod, but don’t we find ourselves in the same spot so often? It’s easy to forget the true reason of why we serve and whom we are serving. We get so driven by success and agendas that our serving becomes very self-centered. But the psalmist Asaph so aptly wrote in **Psalms 76:12, 12** ‘He [the LORD] humbles the spirit of leaders; He is feared by the kings of the earth.’ No matter how ‘large and in-charge’ we may think of ourselves, the LORD is the One who has placed us where we are, and we are here for a reason.

My friends, we must always remember as leaders of people, that we are servants of people. Jesus, the Son of God and Creator of the universe, bent down on his knees and washed His sinful disciples’ dirty feet. He also died on the Cross and rose from the grave to save us from our sins. Christ showed us that great leaders know where they came from and live to make others’ lives better. May we always remember our power comes from the LORD and from people.”
