

# HOUSE JOURNAL

## First Extraordinary Session of the Fifty-fourth Legislature

### of the State of Oklahoma

#### Fourth Legislative Day, Friday, September 6, 2013

The House was called to order by Representative Denney.

The roll was called with 91 Members present.

The following Members were excused: Fourkiller, Grau, Hulbert, Pruett, Renegar, Ritze, Scott, Sherrer, Stiles, Virgin—10.

Representative Denney declared a quorum present.

Prayer was offered by Representative Dan Fisher.

The Journal for the last legislative day was approved.

#### **MOTION**

Representative Reynolds moved that the House Journal from Thursday, September 5, 2013, be amended to reflect that the Senate Bills listed as First Read had not in fact undergone First Reading.

Representative Wright moved to table the Reynolds motion. Prior to consideration of the Wright motion to table, Representative Reynolds raised a point of inquiry stating that he had not offered a motion to amend or correct the House Journal, to which the Presiding Officer responded that corrections to the House Journal are not made on the basis of a suggestion from a member but rather through adoption of a motion by the House of Representatives.

Representative Reynolds renewed his motion to amend the House Journal and Representative Wright renewed his motion to table the Reynolds motion.

Representative Nelson raised a point of inquiry as to how the Supreme Court had previously ruled on the question of constitutionally required readings, to which the Presiding Officer stated that the Chair will not offer a constitutional pronouncement.
