Forty-first Legislative Day, Tuesday, April 14, 2015

The House was called to order by Speaker Pro Tempore Denney.

Invocation was offered by Major Brad Hanna, State Chaplain of the Oklahoma National Guard.

Posting of the Colors was presented by the Governor's Honor Guard.

Lieutenant Governor Lamb recognized Colonel Louis Wilham for introduction of Adjutant General, Major General Robbie Asher.

Major General Asher addressed the Joint Session and conducted the program commemorating the Heritage of the 45th Infantry Division and today's Oklahoma Army and Air National Guard.

Governor Fallin addressed the Joint Session.

Representative McCall escorted Brigadier General (Retired) Harry W. Barnes to the front of the podium.

Colonel Wilham recognized Brigadier General Barnes and his accomplishments.

Colonel Wilham read a formal Proclamation from Governor Fallin recognizing 45th Infantry Division Appreciation Day and presented the Proclamation to Major General Asher.

Lieutenant Governor Lamb made closing remarks to the Joint Session.
