Speaker Hickman moved to amend the Ownbey main amendment, Page 3, Section 1 by striking the word "submit" on Line 14 of the amendment and by adding the following language:

- “:
1. Prior to filing the application for economically at-risk oil or gas lease status with the Tax Commission, in order to provide transparency of economically at-risk oil or gas leases located in the state, file notice of the application with the Corporation Commission which shall include the name and mailing address of the operator and a description of the economically at-risk oil or gas lease and the well or wells within the lease;
 2. Prior to filing the application for economically at-risk oil or gas lease status with the Tax Commission, provide notice by first-class United States mail to the non-operating owners and the royalty owners of the application which shall include the name and mailing address of the operator and a description of the economically at-risk oil or gas lease and the well or wells within the lease;
 3. Provide certification to the Tax Commission at the time of filing the application for economically at-risk oil or gas lease status that the notices as set forth in this section have been provided; and
 4. Submit”.

Representative Rousselot raised a point of inquiry as to whether the amendment to the main amendment had been timely filed, to which the Presiding Officer stated that the

amendment had been filed prior to the deadline and was therefore in order for consideration.
