Representative Inman raised a point of order as to whether the Echols motion was a dilatory motion because the House had previously voted on the same motion prior to the recess taken by the House earlier in the day.

The Presiding Officer ruled that pursuant to *Mason's Manual*, Section 282, Paragraph 6(f) there had been intervening business resulting in a change in the parliamentary situation and that the motion was presently in order.

Representative Morrisette raised a point of order stating that the motion had been previously postponed and that pursuant to *Mason's Manual*, Section 282, the motion was not in order for consideration, to which the Presiding Officer ruled the point not well taken stating that the motion had not been postponed and that the House had previously taken a vote on the motion. The Presiding Officer stated that there had been intervening business resulting in a change in the parliamentary situation and that renewal of the motion was in order.

Representative Morrisette raised a point of inquiry as to whether the present ruling was based on a House rule, a House precedent or upon a provision in *Mason's Manual*, to which the Presiding Officer responded that no House rule or precedent addressed this particular question and that the ruling was based on a provision in *Mason's Manual*.

Representative Nelson raised of point of inquiry as to whether the current motion was distinct from the previously considered motion because it contained two bills, **HB 2205** and **SB 694**, rather than just **HB 2205**, the only measure included in the previous motion to suspend House Rules. The Presiding Officer recognized Representative Echols to explain his motion.

Representative Inman raised a point of order as to whether the House Rules could be suspended for two bills, to which the Presiding Officer responded that such a motion was in order.
