TOPIC OF THE PROPOSAL:

Current penalties and adjudication process for those convicted of Driving under the Influence of Alcohol and/or Intoxicating Substances

EXPLANATORY COMMENTS ON THE SCOPE OF THE STUDY PROPOSAL:

1. The Interim Study will take a global look at the current penalties and process an individual must go through when convicted of DUI/DWI.
2. Examine the range and scope of punishments available for DUI offenders and the use of such penalties by the Court.
3. Examine whether or not the punishments in current law are consistent with one another.
4. Look at how DUI penalties/sentences, drug and alcohol assessment programs and ignition interlocks work together to accomplish the goal of rehabilitation and prevention of offenders.
5. Examine whether or not offenders are complying with the law.
