Children; creating the Task Force on Trauma-Informed Care; effective date.

HB 1065 – By Johns.

Schools; school safety; modifying definition of threatening behavior; effective date.

HB 1114 – By West (Kevin) of the House and Pederson of the Senate.

Public buildings and public works; Public Competitive Building Act of 1974; modifying retainage on certain public contracts; effective date.

HB 1150 – By Grego.

Environment and natural resources; conservation cost-share program; expanding definition; effective date.

State government; employment of attorneys by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; effective date.

Public health and safety; creating the Maternal Mortality Review Act; establishing the Maternal Mortality Review Committee; effective date.

Lottery, Oklahoma Lottery Commission, modifying powers; effective date.

Water; Oklahoma Water Resources Board procedures; directing all applications be disclosed on a website; effective date.
