First Regular Session of the Fifty-eighth Legislature

Fifty-fifth Legislative Day, Monday, May 10, 2021

The House was called to order by Speaker Pro Tempore O'Donnell.

The roll was called with 91 Members present.

The following Members were excused: Bell, Brewer, Bush, Caldwell (Trey), Conley, Hasenbeck, Lowe (Jason), Marti, Nollan, Patzkowsky.—10.

The Speaker Pro Tempore declared a quorum present.

Prayer was offered by Pastor Joel Harder, House Chaplain.

The Journal for the last legislative day was approved.

ENGROSSED AND ENROLLED MEASURES

HBs 1801, 1882, 2365 and 2663 were reported correctly enrolled and, after fourth reading, properly signed, in open session, and ordered transmitted to the Honorable Senate.

HCR 1008 was reported correctly enrolled, properly signed, in open session, and ordered transmitted to the Honorable Senate.

HR 1025 was reported correctly enrolled, properly signed, in open session, and ordered transmitted to the Secretary of State.

RESOLUTIONS

The following were introduced and read:

HR 1031 – By Conley.

A Resolution proclaiming May 2021 as Children’s Mental Health Awareness Month; and encouraging the observation of Children’s Mental Health Awareness Month.

HR 1032 – By Ford.

A Resolution recognizing May 9 through May 15, 2021, as National Police Week and recognizing May 15, 2021, as Peace Officers Memorial Day in the State of Oklahoma.
